The Simple Present

Es un tiempo verbal, utilizado para hablar de nuestra rutina diaria, hábitos y costumbres.

Las oraciones afirmativas únicamente llevan tres elementos: SUJETO + VERBO + COMPLEMENTO.

Ejemplos: I eat rice = Yo como arroz / You read every day = Usted lee todos los días

We study English= Nosotros estudiamos Inglés / It catches the ball = Este atrapa el balón.

En el presente Simple los verbos auxiliares Do y Does acompañan a cada uno de los pronombres personales :

<i>Pronoun</i>	<i>Conjugation</i>
I	Do
He She It	Does
You We They	Do

Oraciones Negativas: Sujeto + Do/Does + Not + Verbo + Complemento

Ejemplos : I don't eat rice = Yo no como arroz / You don't read every day = Usted no lee todos los días. / We don't study English. / It doesn't catch the ball = Este no atrapa el balón.

En las oraciones encontramos las formas abreviadas. Estas se forman al unir los verbos auxiliares do y does + not.

Después de la n, debemos colocar el apóstrofe (la coma que va en la parte superior ´)

Así: do + not = don't y does + not = doesn't

Oraciones Interrogativas : Do / Does + Sujeto + Verbo + Complemento + ?

Ejemplos: Do you eat rice ? = Come usted arroz? / Do you read every day ? = Lee usted todos los días ? / Do we study English? = Estudiamos nosotros Inglés ? / Does it catch the ball ? / Atrapa este el balón ?

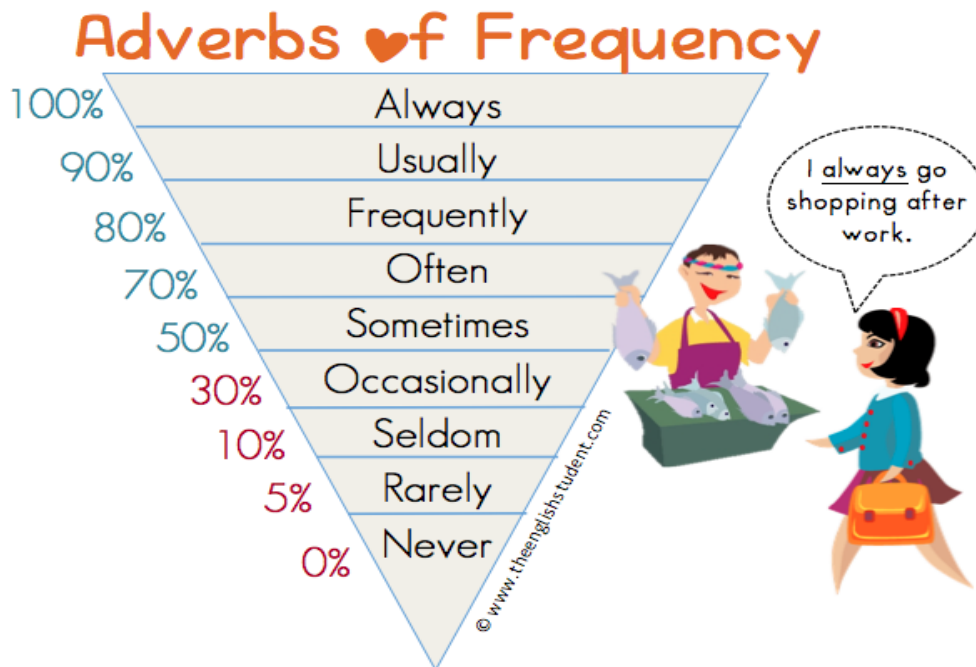
Cuando elaboramos oraciones afirmativas , utilizando los pronombres: He / She / It. Debemos tener en cuenta , las siguientes reglas :

- Agregar s después del verbo
- Si el verbo termina en sh – ch – x – o , agregamos es al verbo
- Si el verbo termina en consonante + Y. Se cambia la y por i y se agrega es al final del verbo.
- Si el verbo termina en vocal + Y, únicamente agregamos s al final del verbo.

Ejemplos:

- She lives in Colombia = Ella vive en Colombia / He runs every day = El corre todos los días
- He washes the dishes = El lava los platos / She goes to the store = Ella va a la tienda.
- He studies English = El estudia Inglés / She carries the books = Ella lleva los libros
- He plays soccer = El juega fútbol / She says a poem = Ella dice un poema.

ADVERBIOS DE FRECUENCIA



Son palabras utilizadas para expresar la frecuencia con la que realizamos alguna actividad.

Ejemplos: I always drink water = Yo siempre bebo agua / They always brush their teeth = Ellos siempre cepillan sus dientes.

She usually eats candies = Ella usualmente come dulces. / You always do your homework = Usted siempre hace su tarea.

He frequently plays the guitar = El con frecuencia toca la guitarra. / I frequently water the plants = Yo con frecuencia riego las plantas.

He often uses the computer = El con frecuencia usa el computador. / I often clean my bedroom = Yo con frecuencia limpio mi cuarto.

I sometimes drink soda = Yo algunas veces bebo gaseosa. / They sometimes play cards = Ellos algunas veces juegan cartas.

He occasionally goes to the store = El ocasionalmente va a la tienda. / They occasionally buy vitamins = El ocasionalmente compra vitaminas.

She seldom goes to the doctor = Ella rara vez va al médico. / They seldom watch T.V. = Ellos rara vez miran televisión.

She rarely wears sandals = Ella rara vez usa sandalias. / I rarely listen to Jazz music = Yo rara vez escucho Jazz.

I never fly to London = Yo nunca vuela a Londres / He never mop the floor = El nunca trapea el piso.

Recuerda que los adverbios de frecuencia generalmente van antes del verbo.

Para preguntar a alguien, con que frecuencia realiza una acción determinada , utilizamos la expresión : How Often.

Ejemplo: How often do you eat bread? / R= I always eat bread (Con que frecuencia come pan ?/

R= Yo siempre como pan.)

How often do you listen to music? / R = I frequently listen to music. (Con que frecuencia escucha música? / R= Frecuentemente escucho música.)
