EL FUTURO CON WILL Y GOING TO

Will

Es un auxiliar, también conocido como verbo modal. Esto quiere decir que nos valemos de él para crear una forma del verbo, en este caso, el futuro.

Nota: will siempre irá acompañado de un verbo en su forma base (Infinitivo) para formar el futuro. En caso contrario, will se convierte en sustantivo y significa voluntad

Utilizamos will para expresar una decisión tomada al momento de hablar

Ejemplos:

I will call him right now. - Lo llamaré ahora mismo.

I'll help you with those bags. - Te ayudaré con esas bolsas.

I won't let you pass. - No te dejaré pasar.

También podemos usar will para hacer predicciones generales sobre algo que creemos sucederá en algún momento (futuro). Estas predicciones no cuentan con una evidencia física que las soporte.

It will rain (lloverá) / He will win the race tomorrow (El ganara la carrera mañana)

Don't worry, you won't have any troubles during your trip. (No te preocupes, no tendrás problemas durante tu viaje

Going to

Uso de Going to

Going to se utiliza para expresar planes o hechos contundentes a futuro.

Es importante anotar que en esta forma del tiempo futuro se hace uso del verbo to be en forma presente, por ejemplo:

Usos de going to:

1. Para expresar un plan:

Lucas is going to make another movie.

(Lucas va a hacer otra película.)

2. Expresa la intención de una persona para realizar algo en tiempo futuro:

Miss Anderson is going to be a juror in the contest.

(La señorita Anderson va a ser jurado en el concurso.)

3. Expresa algo sobre lo que se tenga certeza:

It's going to rain.

(Va a llover.)
